Course Synopsis

Participants will have taken the EW1 course prior to joining the course. The literature journey will take you to places of knowledge wonders that your fore-researchers have gone through. Most importantly, it will take you to new potentials, which you have no vision before, and give you a first draft manuscript for journal publication.

The uniqueness of this workshop is that E.A.G.L.E. understands the problem faced by researchers when drafting their own scientific article paper. Through this understanding, the E.A.G.L.E. Program offer in-class structured guidelines on creating theory in just 3 days! Understanding how to utilize literature review and critically reviewing are the most challenging parts of writing the article. This process will end with a precise synthesis called a theory.

The E.A.G.L.E. workshop strengthen theory creation by participants to contribute new knowledge in their own fields. There is minimum requirement to have a novel theory before graduating as a PhD, and that is why this workshop is highly recommended for those who are pursuing Master & PhD degrees. It is expected to benefit Master/ PhD students, and business persons who wants to plan new R&D/business, and challengers of innovation.

Literature Review

There are 4 levels of simple and fast approach in conducting and documenting critical literature review process. Participants will be guided to systematically prepare the critical content and draft their manuscripts according to its increasing complexity. At the end of Level 2, participants will have the first draft for a conference proceeding.

Point of Departure

This E.A.G.L.E. course continues the earlier the Literature Review experience by working with the Point of Departure Tree Diagram tool. At the advanced Level 3 & 4, participants will build and discover their own theoretical discoveries needed for SCOPUS Q3/Q4 manuscript scripting.

First Drafts

Participants will learn the requirements for different type of publications as they go through the structured program. Participants will be given tips on additional requirements to enable a SCOPUS Q3/Q4 manuscript to be upgraded for SCOPUS Q1/Q2 submission. The expected outputs of this course are a completed conference proceeding manuscript and a first draft manuscript for a SCOPUS Q3/Q4 journal.

Trainer and study materials

Prof. Dr. Rahinah Ibrahim is Certified Expert Trainer and lead the course in English.
Dr Mayumi Nomura is Certified Fundamental Trainer and will assist in Japanese.
Workbook is written in English and Japanese.
